Surface: Supply your own clip board, make sure it has a paintable surface. The size is approximately 9X12, clip or roller (either type is fine). The stands will be given out at the class.

Supplies: Jean will have several bottles of paint that she will share at the class if you can't find these colors. However, you will need to prep your piece ahead of time with Americana SILVER SAGE GREEN or SLATE GREEN. Jean will have a vellum pattern for us, and a double sided laminated sheet with hydrangeas on one side and roses on the other. We will be able to practice right on the laminated sheets and wipe off practice flowers with baby wipes.

Bring your regular acrylic painting supplies including transfer paper, stylus, baby wipes, wet palette, brushes and paints.

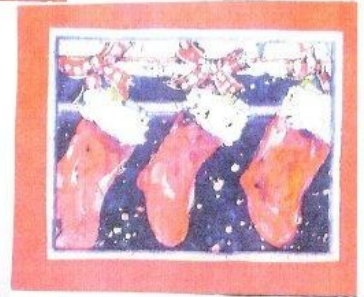

Supplies:

- Micron Pen, Black, size 05 or 08 (not Sharpie)
- Brushes - one round - suggested size 4 or 5, One flat - suggested size 6, Liner - any size, Old small brushes for waxing (these will only be useful for waxing once they are used for that purpose.)
- 3 small sheets waxed paper to go under rice paper when waxing - (we will be using 5"X5" pieces of rice paper).
- Small piece of freezer paper or foam board to go under rice paper when using watercolors
- SUPPLIES TO BRING IF YOU HAVE THEM: Newspapers, Iron, Hair dryer
- Don't forget your lunch.

TIP: When transferring a pattern to a different size or shape surface than the original design, always cut apart all the elements before arranging on the new surface. Using the design as is (or just moving it around as you transfer the parts of the design) seldom leads to the most pleasing composition on the new surface.

For transferring onto a curved surface - some designers trace the design on plastic wrap like Saran with a Sharpie and then transfer. I prefer to cut slits at intervals around the edge of the design, place on surface, and then tape the overlapping slit edges together ... try both.

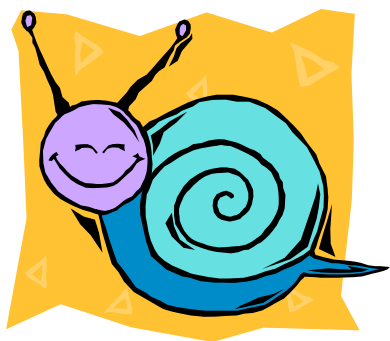
