Supplies: Bring you're usual acrylic supplies.

Tips from Peggy Harris ...

Universal shading = Dioxazine Purple + Raw Umber + a medium to make transparent (water, gels, Magic Mix, etc. appropriate for the medium used). More purple for cooler shadows, more Umber for warmer.

TIP: use a mini angular when painting irises ... angle lets you get in small spaces, while the flat shape helps blend as you go ... remember, rounds leave ridges. I use a 12/0 Ultra Mini from SilverBrush.

TIP: always enlarge your reference photos to the same size as your painting (or as close as possible) ... you will paint better when you have a direct one to one ratio ... believe me !! This is true for everything from strokework to portraits ...

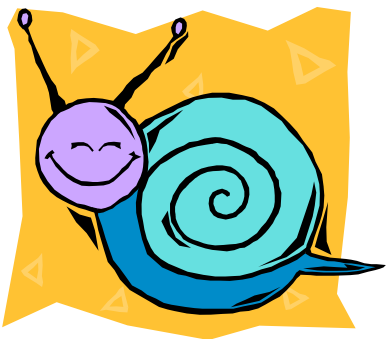
